NEXT STEPS

Add your tick once completed

- Book your venue viewing at the Dukes Head Hotel
- Provisionally hold your date whilst you check availability with Norfolk registrars
- Decide on your guest list... don't worry you can refine this closer to the time
- Pay your deposit to confirm your date and confirm your church or registrars
- Confirm your guest list and send save the date cards
- Provisionally hold bedrooms for your wedding guests
- Time to decide on your Bridal Party & Groomsmen
- Contact your preferred suppliers for availability and book (photographer, florist, venue dresser etc.)
- Start the search for your wedding outfits
- Decide on your menu and book a tasting
- Choose your cake and attend the tasting
- Send out wedding invitations with an RSVP approx. 4 months prior to the wedding
- Choose your music for the day, a track list for your ceremony & your first dance
- 6 months prior, book a meeting to discuss further plans including themes, timings, bedrooms, setup
- Order and collect your wedding rings
- 3 months prior, chase any remaining RSVP's and book a meeting to talk through your day and plans
- 6 weeks prior, any guests who haven't booked their room we will then release any unrequired bedrooms
- Enjoy your stag or hen parties
- 1 month prior to the wedding, organise a meeting with your venue to run through all and final details
